The "Traders'" index of prices of the twenty-five best selling industrial and public utility common stocks, on the Montreal and Toronto Exchanges, was 397.3 for the week ending July 12th as compared with 403.2 for the previous week. The "Investors'" index of domestic utility common stocks was 141.1 for the week ending July 12th as compared with 141.3 for the previous week. The "Investors'" index for common stocks of companies located abroad in which Canadians are heavily interested was 153.3 for the week ending July 12th
