Inventories on hand at February 1, 1954 and 1955, are shown here, for the first time, at cost price. Previous reports in this series contained inventories at selling price. Any difference between these estimates and those published previously at selling price will be due to mark-up and a different method of estimation. In certain instances, estimates have been corrected because of improper inventory reporting of some firms.

Stock holdings were formerly estimated by applying the current stock/sales ratio of a sample of firms to total estimated chain store sales for six major trades. A new sample of firms now covers all trades, results for eleven of which are considered of significant importance to publish sales and stock estimates. Stocks are now estimated by linking current-month stocks of the sample firms to end-of-year stocks and applying this index to the year-end total cost-price stocks as obtained from the anmal full-coverage survey of retail chain stores.

Estimated stocks at cost price for 1954, by months, are shown on the reverse side.
