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DEPARTMENT STORE SALES AND STOCKS

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Canadian department stores had estimated sales during May 1957 of \$108,585,000 a gain of 5.6% above sales of \$102,829,000 in the corresponding month last year. With the addition of May, sales for the five-month period were estimated to be \$463,092,000, an increase of 5.2% over those for the same period in 1956. Stocks held by department stores had an estimated selling value of \$316,869,000 on April 30 this year, 8.9% greater than the \$290,855,000 value at the same date a year earlier. These and other estimates contained in this bulletin are not adjusted for seasonal variations, price changes or number of shopping days.

British Columbia showed the largest percentage gain in sales (12.4%) during the month of May as compared with the same month a year earlier. Manitoba with an increase of 12.0% was a very close second followed by Alberta, Quebec, Ontario and Saskatchewan with increases of 8.3%, 4.4%, 3.1% and 1.6% respectively. The Atlantic Provinces with a decrease of 1.2% was the only region where sales fell below those of May last year.

Twenty-two of the twenty-nine specified departments as well as the "All Other" category registered greater sales this May than last. For more detail of sales and stocks by department see page 2.
