## WHOLESALE TRADE NOVEMBER, 1951

The dollar volume of sales in November 1951 was $8 \%$ above the 1950 November level, with all regions contributing to the increase. Sales $1 n$ the Maritime Provinces were 11\% above November 1950, and the increases ranged downward to $\%$ in the Prairies and quebec. The cumulative figures for the first eleven months of 1951 were 11\% above the dollar volume of sales in the same period of 1950.

The results shown in this report are based on returns from about 400 wholesalers distributed over nine trades. They reflect trends in dollar volume of business and are not adjusted for changes in wholesale prices.


The unadjusted index for the total of the nine trades (on the base 1935-1939 $=100$ ) stood at 354.0 for November 1951 compared with 326.9 for November a year ago and 375.4 for October 1951.

Stocks on hand at the end of November were $11 \%$ greater in dollar volume than at the end of November in 1950. Inventories showed the greatest gains in the fruft and vegetable, and the auto parts and equipment trades. The dollar volume of inventory remained unchanged in two trades and was $5 \%$ below the level of a year ago in drug wholesalers.

As in the case of inventories, fruit and vegetable wholesalers took the lead in sales increase during November 1951 with a gain of 20\%. 111 trades except two registered increases in sales. Sales of hardware wholesalers were $2 \%$ below the November 1950 level and dry goods wholesalers sales, lof lower in dollar volume.
