

The unadjusted index for the total of the nine trades (on the base, average for 1935-1939=100) stood at 348.7 for September 1951 compared with 352.1 for September 1950 and 362.3 for August 1951.

Stocks on hand at the end of September remained at a comparatively high level, 18% above the dollar volume of inventories held at the end of September 1950. The dollar volume of sales was greater this September than last in five of the nine trades. Fruit and vegetable wholesalers recorded the largest gain at 8% above September 1950, while dry goods wholesalers showed the greatest decline in sales with a drop of 16% from a year ago. Clothing wholesalers recorded a smaller decline in sales volume, 9% below September 1950.

Wholesalers of auto parts and equipment reported the greatest increase in inventories from last year with a gain of 43%. Marked gains were also shown for dry goods, hardware, clothing, and fruit and vegetable wholesalers. Stocks of tobacco and confectionery wholesalers were 11% below last year in dollar volume.

Sales in September were below those of August in Ontario and the Western Provinces. Quebec and the Maritimes showed gains in sales volume.
