 SEPTEMBER, 1951

Dollar volume of sales in September 1951 was slightly below the September 1950 level ( $-0.8 \%$ ), the second month of 1951 in which sales were below last year's totals. Cumulative figures for the nine months of this year showed sales up $11 \%$ over the same period of 1950.

The results shown in this report are based on returns from about 400 wholesalers distributed over nine trades. They rerlect trends in dollar volume of business and are not adjusted for changes in wholesale prices.


The unadjusted index for the total of the nine trades (on the base, average for $1935-1939=100$ ) stood at 348.7 for September 1951 compared with 352.1 for September 1950 and 362.3 for hueust 1951.

Stocks on hand at the end of September remained at a comparatively high level, $18 \%$ above the dollar volune of inventories held at the end of September 1950. The dollar volume of sales was greater this September than last in five of the nine trades. Fruit and vegetable wholesalers recorded the largest gain et $8 \%$ above September 1950, while dry goods wholesalers showed the greatest decline in sales with a drop of $16 \%$ from a year ago. Clothing wholesalers recorded a smaller decline in sales volume, $9 \%$ below September 1950.

Wholesalers of auto parts and equipment reported the greatest increase in inventories from last year with a gain of $43 \%$. Marked gains were also shown for dry goods, hardware, clothing, and fruit and vegetable wholesalers. Stocks of tobacco and confectionery wholesalers were $11 \%$ below last year in dollar volume.

Sales in September were below those of fugust in Ontario and the Western Provinces. Quebec and the Maritimes showed gains in sales volume.
