


WHOLESALE TRADE

JUNE 1952

The results shown in this report are based on returns from 400 wholesalers distributed over nine trades. They reflect trends in dollar volume of business and are not adjusted for changes in wholesale prices.

The unadjusted index for the total of the nine trades (on the base of 1935-1939=100) stood at 369.2 for June 1952 compared with 357.3 for June a year ago and 390.3 for May 1952.

Sales Trends by Trades

June sales of wholesalers in the trades covered by this survey were 3% higher than in June last year. Wholesalers of fruits and vegetables with increased sales of 19% recorded the greatest gain over June 1951. Sales of auto parts and equipment and clothing increased 16% and 12% respectively. Smaller gains of 8% and 3% respectively were reported by wholesalers of drugs and tobacco and confectionery. Sales of hardware with a decline of 4% registered the greatest drop from June 1951. Slight decreases in sales were also reported by wholesalers of footwear, groceries and dry goods.

Inventories

Inventories at the end of June declined 7% from the same date last year. The greatest drop occurred in the clothing trade which reported a decline of 27% in stocks from the end of June 1951. Decreases in inventories were recorded in all trades except fruits and vegetables and drugs. Stocks of fruits and vegetables rose 11% while stocks of drugs were 4% higher than at the end of June a year ago.
