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

WHOLESALE TRADE

JUNE; 1953

The results shown in this report are based on returns from 400 wholesalers distributed over nine trades. They reflect trends in dollar volume of business and are not adjusted for changes in wholesale prices.

The unadjusted index for the total of the nine trades (on the base of 1935-1939=100) stood at 378.9 for June 1953 compared with 368.5 for June a year ago and 375.9 for May 1953.



Sales Trends by Trades

Wholesale sales moved upward in June, sales for the nine trades covered in this survey being 2% higher than in the same month last year. Wholesalers of auto parts and equipment again reported the greatest gain in sales - 8% above June last year. Sales of drugs and hardware were 7% higher, followed by sales of groceries with an increase of 5%. Wholesalers of tobacco and confectionery and clothing recorded smaller gains of 2% and 1% respectively. Sales of fruits and vegetables with a decline of 10% registered the greatest drop. Dry goods sales declined 4% and footwear 3%.

Inventories

Stocks held by wholesalers were 4% higher at the end of June 1953 than at the same date last year. Higher inventories, ranging from less than 1% to 21%, were reported by all trades with the exceptions of fruits and vegetables and drugs. Stocks held by fruit and vegetable wholesalers were 6% lower, while stocks of drugs declined 4%.
