## WHOLESALE TRADE

## DECEMBER 1949

1949 Total Up 38 from 1948; December Sales 18 Above December, 1948
December, 1949 sales of wholesalere exceeded the December, 1948 dollar volume by i\% but were $14 \%$ below baies in November, 1949 , according to statements submitted by 363 wholegalers ropresenting nine lines of trade. Preliminary results for the year 1949 indicate that the dollar ales volume in that year was 3\% in excess of the volume for the 12 montha of 1948 . The general unadjusted index (on the base, average for $1935-1939=100$ ) Btood at 263.3 for Deceaber. 1949, 259.9 for December, 1948 , and 306.7 Por November, 1949.

Sales in British Columbia, the Maritime Provinces, and quebec continued the trend of the past few months by falling ahort of the 1948 volume. Sales in British Columbia were down 1\%, in the Maritime Provinces, 34, while Quebeo wholesalers regletered a decline of 5\%. Wholeealers in the Prairie Provinces and Ontario reported dollar sales 48 and $5 \%$ reepectively higher than in December, 1948.

Geins registered for 5 trades out of 9
Drug and tobacco and confectionery wholesalers again reported the groatest increases in sales over 1948. Sales of drug wholesalers were $16 \%$ in excess of the December, 1948, level, resulting in a $9 \%$ increase for the year 1949 as compared with 1948. Tobacco and confectionery wholesalers' sales in December, 1949, were $8 \%$ higher than in Docember of the previous year, while the cumulative sales for the year 1949 exceeded the 1948 volume by $5 \%$ 。

Docember, 1949, sales of fruit and vegetable dealers were up $5 \%$ over the previous December, while automotive equipment and grocery wholesalers both registered gains of $4 \%$ in dollar volume. The 12 -month total sales volume for 1949 for fruit and vegetable wholesalers was $12 \%$ higher than the 1948 dollar volume, automotive equipment wholesalers ${ }^{\circ}$ sales registered a $5 \%$ gain for the year 1949 over 1948, while grocery wholesalers' sales registered an increase of $1 \%$ for the year 1949 compared with 1948 .

Dollar sales of hardware wholesalers in December, 1949 were $6 \%$ below the Decomber, 1948, volume, bringing the cumulative total for the year to $4 \%$ above the 1948 level. Clothing and footwear wholesalers both roported decreases of $13 \%$ in Docember, 1949, compared with December, 1948, while dry goods wholesalers' sales dropped $16 \%$. Preliminary sales figures for these trades for the yoar 1949 indicate decreases from 1948 of $2 \%$ for footwear wholesalers' sales, $7 \%$ for clothing wholesalors' sales, and $9 \%$ for dry goods wholestlers' sales.

Inventorios down 1\% fram Decomber 31, 1948
Stocks on hand of wholestlers in the nine trades included in this survey were valued $1 \%$ lower at December 31,1949 , than at the end of 1948 , and $4 \%$ below November 30, 1949.

Marked increases in the value of inventorios were reported by automotive equipment and footwear wholesalors at $24 \%$ and $33 \%$ respectively. Smaller gains of from $3 \%$ to $5 \%$ wore reported by drug, hardware, and dry goods wholesalors.

Tobacco and confectionery wholosalers inventorios were valued $4 \%$ bel ow Docember 31,1948, while the value of fruit and vegetable dealer ${ }^{\prime}$ inventories declined $9 \%$. Greater decreases in value of stocks on hand compared with Docember 31, 1948, were reoorded for olothing and grocery wholesalers at $15 \%$ and $17 \%$ respectively.

## Stocks-Salos Ratio in the Wholesale Grocory Trade

Stocks held by wholesale grocers at the beginning of December are normally $64 \%$ in excess of sales for that month (based on the average for the years $1936-1942$ ). Wholesale grocers ${ }^{2}$ stocks at the beginning of Docember,1949, were valued $18 \%$ higher than their sales during December.
