
Dollar Sales up 7% from 1948

Dollar sales of wholesalers in August, 1949 were 7% above dollar volume in August, 1948, and 11% above sales in July, 1949. These figures are based on statements submitted by 376 wholesalers representing nine lines of trade. Cumulative sales for the first eight months of 1949 were 5% in excess of sales during the corresponding period of 1948. The general unadjusted index (on the base, average for 1935-1939 = 100) stood at 316.9 for August, 1949, 296.7 for August, 1948, and 284.9 for July, 1949.

Gains were recorded for all regions of the country and ranged from 11% for the Prairie Provinces, through 6% for British Columbia and Ontario, to 4% and 3% respectively for Quebec and the Maritime Provinces.

Increases Greater in August than in July

A general widening of the margin of increase and smaller decreases were evident in August compared with July. Seven of the nine trades recorded increased sales over August 1948 while only two trades showed lower sales in August this year than last.

Fruit and vegetable wholesalers again reported the largest increase over a year ago at 23%. Drug, automotive equipment, and hardware wholesalers' sales increased 14%, 12%, and 11% respectively, while tobacco and confectionery wholesalers reported sales 9% above August, 1948. Sales of clothing wholesalers and grocery wholesalers were both up 2%.

Footwear wholesalers indicated dollar sales 3% lower in August than in the same month a year ago, while a drop of 9% from last year was recorded for dry goods wholesalers.

Inventories 7% Higher

Stocks in the hands of wholesalers in the nine trades included in the survey were valued 7% higher at the end of August, 1949 than at the corresponding date a year ago and 3% lower than at July 31, 1949. Five of the nine trades contributed to this increase. Stocks held by wholesalers of hardware and automotive equipment were 13% and 12% respectively greater in dollar value than the inventory value a year ago. Inventories of tobacco and confectionery wholesalers were up 9% while a 7% increase was registered by dry goods and drug wholesalers.

Fruit and vegetable dealers and grocery wholesalers both showed a decrease of 3% in value of stocks on hand, while footwear wholesalers' inventories were down 2% in value and those of clothing wholesalers were 1% below the value at August 31, 1948.

Stocks-Sales Ratio in the Wholesale Grocery Trade

Stocks held by wholesale grocers at the beginning of August are normally 11% in excess of sales for that month (based on the average for the years 1936-1942). Stocks in the hands of wholesale grocers at the beginning of August this year were valued 9% lower than the sales for that month.
