

WHOLESALE TRADE

The results shown in this report are based on returns from 400 wholesalers distributed over nine trades. They reflect trends in dollar volume of business and are not adjusted for changes in wholesale prices.

The unadjusted index for the total of the nine trades (on the base of 1935-1939 = 100) stood at 293.7 for January 1954 compared with 309.2 for January a year ago and 343.3 for December 1953.

Sales Trends by Trades

Wholesale sales in January 1954 decreased 6% as compared with sales in January 1953, according to figures submitted by wholesalers in the nine trades covered in this survey. All trades, with the exception of auto parts and equipment and groceries, reported decreased sales. Wholesalers of footwear reported sales 23% below those for January last year; sales of dry goods declined 21%, clothing 17%, hardware 14%, tobacco and confectionery 13% and fruit and vegetables 12%. A smaller drop of 3% was reported by wholesalers of drugs. Sales of auto parts and equipment and groceries increased 12% and 3% respectively.

Inventories

The value of stocks held by wholesalers at the end of January 1954 showed a fractional decrease from the same period a year ago. Stocks of fruit and vegetables declined 11%, hardware 6% and groceries and drugs 1%. Substantial increases in inventory ranging from 19% to 11% were reported for footwear, auto parts and equipment, tobacco and confectionery and clothing. Dry goods' stocks, on the other hand, showed no change from last year.
