The results shown in this ropart are besed on returns from 400 wholesalere distributed over nine tredes. They reflect trende in dollar volums of businoss and are not adfusted for changes in uholesalo prices.

The unadjusted index for the total of the nine traden (on the base of 1935-1939=100) stood at 388.8 for October 1954 com pared with 399.4 for October a year ago and 401.8 for September 1954.

## Salos Tronds by Irader

The October salos of wholosalors in the nine tredes covered by this report were 2.1\% below the sales of the same nonth last rear, and 3.2\% below the previons month. The decreases wore most ovident in the clothing and dry goods lines where sales were $17.3 \%$ and $11.0 \%$ below the level of a year ago. Hardware wholosslers also showed a considerable docreaso, 10.48 below sales of October 1953. Fruit and vegotable wholosalers reported the greatost gain ( $+8.4 \%$ ) of the three trades repistering increased sales this month.

## Invontories

A slight decline in the dollar value of inventory holdings at the ond of October 1954 campared with 1953 was reported. The deareased inventorios of the clothing and dry goods trados contributed largely to the lols drop of the nine trade total. Pootwear wholesalers reported a reduction of $30.8 \%$ in inventorios at the end of October this yoar than at the same date of 1953. Clothing and dry goods were $10.7 \%$ and $8.0 \%$ lower respectively. Inventories of frult and vegetable wholesalors were $8.6 \%$ above the level of October 31, 1953 while three other trados showed nominal gains. Inventories at the end of October were $0.7 \%$ above those on hand at September 30 .
