

WHOLESALE TRADE OCTOBER 1954

The results shown in this report are based on returns from 400 wholesalers distributed over nine trades. They reflect trends in dollar volume of business and are not adjusted for changes in wholesale prices.

The unadjusted index for the total of the nine trades (on the base of 1935-1939=100) stood at 388.8 for October 1954 compared with 399.4 for October a year ago and 401.8 for September 1954.

Sales Trends by Trades

The October sales of wholesalers in the nine trades covered by this report were 2.1% below the sales of the same month last year, and 3.2% below the previous month. The decreases were most evident in the clothing and dry goods lines where sales were 17.3% and 11.0% below the level of a year ago. Hardware wholesalers also showed a considerable decrease, 10.4% below sales of October 1953. Fruit and vegetable wholesalers reported the greatest gain (+8.4%) of the three trades registering increased sales this month.

Inventories

A slight decline in the dollar value of inventory holdings at the end of October 1954 compared with 1953 was reported. The decreased inventories of the clothing and dry goods trades contributed largely to the 1.1% drop of the nine trade total. Footwear wholesalers reported a reduction of 30.8% in inventories at the end of October this year than at the same date of 1953. Clothing and dry goods were 10.7% and 8.0% lower respectively. Inventories of fruit and vegetable wholesalers were 8.6% above the level of October 31, 1953 while three other trades showed nominal gains. Inventories at the end of October were 0.7% above those on hand at September 30.
