## WHOLESALE TRADE <br> APRIL 1954

The results shown in this report are besed on returns from 400 wholesalers distributed over nine trades. They reflect trends in dollar volume of business and are not adjusted for changes in wholesale prices.

The unadjusted index for the total of the nine trades (on the base of 1935-1939 = 100) stood at 356.9 for April 1954 compared with 366.6 for April a year ago and 352.3 for March 1954.

## Sales Trends by Trades

Wholesale sales were $2 \%$ lower in April 1954 than in the same month a year ago, according to reports received from wholesalers in the nine trades covered by this survey. Largest drop from April last year was in the footwear trade, with a sales decline of $14 \%$. Sales of dry goods, clothing and hardware declined $12 \%, 11 \%$ and $10 \%$ respectively. Wholesalers of auto parts and equipment reported a seles drop of $3 \%$ while sales of tobacco and confectionery were $1 \%$ lower. Sales of fruits and vegetables dropped less than 1\%. An increase in sales of 38 was reported by the grocery and drug trades.

## Inventories

The value of stocks held by wholesalers at the end of April 1954 showed a slight decline of less than 18 from the same period a year ago. Stocks of dry goods and fruits and vegetables declined $14 \%$ while hardware stocks dropped $3 \%$ and footwear and drugs $1 \%$. Inventory values were higher at the end of April this year in groceries (10\%), clothing (9\%), auto parts and equipment (7\%) and tobacco and confectionery (1\%).
