

The results shown in this report are based on returns from 400 wholesalers distributed over nine trades. They reflect trends in dollar volume of business and are not adjusted for changes in wholesale prices.

The unadjusted index for the total of the nine trades (on the base of 1935 - 1939 = 100) stood at 370.6 for July 1954 compared with 379.6 for July a year ago and 390.9 for June 1954.

Sales Trends by Trades

July sales of wholesalers covered by this report registered a decrease of 2% over the same month of 1953 and a decline of 5% from June 1954. In comparison with the previous year seven of the nine trades showed declines ranging from 7% for hardware wholesalers to less than half of one per cent for grocery wholesalers. Fruit and vegetable wholesalers reported an increase of almost 5% while a 1% increase was shown by drug wholesalers.

Inventories

There was a 1% decrease in the value of stocks on hand at the end of July 1954 compared with the corresponding period in 1953. Large decreases were reported by footwear wholesalers amounting to 19% while there was a decrease of 12% for both clothing and dry goods wholesalers. Tobacco and confectionery wholesalers reported an increase of 14%, fruit and vegetable wholesalers nearly 12% and grocery wholesalers over 8%.
