The unadjusted index for the total of the nine trades (on the base of $1935-1939=100$ ) stood at 303.4 for January 1955 cont pared with 294.1 for January a year ago and 357.1 for December 1954.

## Sales Trends by Trades

Wholesale sales for the nine trades covered by this report showed an increase of $3.5 \%$ for January 1955 when cormared with January 1054 while sales were $15.0 \%$ below the previous month. Flve of the nine trades reported increases in comparison with the corresponding month of the previous year and these ranged from $1.7 \%$ for grocery wholesalers to $14.7 \%$ for fruit and vegetable wholesalers. Of the four trades reporting decreases the range varied from $2.0 \%$ for dry goods wholesalers to $10.7 \%$ for footwear wholesalers.

## Inventories

For the nine wholesale trades as a whole a general stability in terms of dollar value of inventories continued with January inventories 0.1\% under those of the corresponding month of the previous year. Flve of the nine trades reported decreases and four increases in the comparison with the previous year. Large decreases of $7.9 \%$ and $7.8 \%$ respectively were reported by footwear and dry goods wholesalers while increases of $10.8 \%$ were reported by grocery wholesalers and $9.9 \%$ by frut and vegotable wholesalers.
