## WHOLESALE TRADE

## DECEMBER 1955

The preliminary estinates of wholesale sales, unadjusted for price changes or seasonal variations, for the month of December, 1955, was $\$ 549,903,000$. This represents an increase of $0.8 \%$ over sales for the same month in 1954. All except two trade classifications showed an increase and increases ranged from $100.4 \%$ in the case of farm machinery to $0.7 \%$ in the case of newsprint, paper and paper products. The residual group recorded a decrease of $27.1 \%$ and the construction materials group decreased $0.4 \%$.

Gumulative calculations, also set out in the table accompanying this report, show the preliminary estimate of wholesale sales for the year 1955 as $\$ 6,749,508,000$ which is an increase of $11.1 \%$ over the previous year.
