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

## WHOLESALE TRADE

**MAY 1955** 

The results shown in this report are based on returns from 400 wholesalers distributed over nine trades. They reflect trends in dollar volume of business and are not adjusted for changes in wholesale prices.

The unadjusted index for the total of the nine trades (on the base of 1935 - 1939 = 100) stood at 399.2 for May 1955 compared with 369.6 for May a year ago and 369.1 for April 1955.

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## Sales Trends by Trades

All except one of the nine wholesale trades covered in this report showed increased sales during May, 1955, to make a total gain for all nine trades of 7.4% over 1954. Auto parts and equipment wholesalers showed the largest gain (12.1%), followed by grocery wholesalers (10.2%), tobacco and confectionery wholesalers (8.7%), drug wholesalers (8.2%) and clothing wholesalers (7.7%). Smaller gains were made in the remaining trades with the exception of dry goods which decreased slightly (1.5%).

## Inventories

In total the nine trades reported 3.4% less inventory value at the end of May, 1955, than at the same date in 1954. Fruit and vegetable wholesalers reported the largest increase (14.3%). Five trades reported decreases ranging from -8.5% to -0.9%.
