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

WHOLESALE TRADE

JUNE 1955

The results shown in this report are based on returns from 400 wholesalers distributed over nine trades. They reflect trends in dollar volume of business and are not adjusted for changes in wholesale prices.

The unadjusted index for the total of the nine trades (on the base of 1935 - 1939 = 100) stood at 416.2 for June 1955 compared with 390.9 for June a year ago and 399.3 for May 1955.

Sales Trends by Trades

Auto parts and equipment made the largest gain in June over the same month last year (17.0%), followed by dry goods (7.4%) and tobacco and confectionery (6.8%). Other trades made smaller gains with the exception of fruits and vegetables which recorded a decrease of 3.4%. The composite figure was a gain of 5.7%.

Inventories

Fruits and vegetables showed the largest inventory increase (11.9%) while hardware inventories decreased by 5.5%. Inventory changes in the other trades ranged between these figures, the overall change being a decrease of 1.4%.
