## WHOLESALE TRADE

November 1956

Preliminary estimates of wholesale sales in November advanced 13 per cent above November 1955 to $\$ 676,085,000$ from $\$ 598,159,000$ and 14 per cent in the January to November period to $\$ 7,090,282,000$ from $\$ 6,197,608,000$. These sales cover "wholesalers proper" and do not include the business transactions of manifacturers ${ }^{1}$ sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

Sales in November were up in all the specified trade groups except farm machinery, household electrical appliances and automotive parts and accessories which accounted for decreases of 24,5 and 1 per cent respectively. The greatest gains were registered for commercial, institutional and service equipment and supplies ( 18 per cent), groceries and food specialties ( 15 per cent) and tobacco, confectionery and soft drinks (12 per cent) while their increases in the JanuaryNovember period were recorded at approximately 10 per cent in each case. The largest increases in the January to November period were: industrial and transportation equipment and supplies, 34 per cent; farm machinery, 21 per cent; coal and coke, 16 per cent. The "all other trades" group advanced 34 per cent in the month and 21 per cent in the cumulative January-November period.
