### WHOLESALE TRADE

#### April 1957

Estimated wholesale sales in April at \$660,263,000 were only a fraction (0.5 per cent) higher than the \$657,226,000 registered for the same month last year. Omnulative sales for the year to date were up 7.2 per cent to \$2,478,910,000 from \$2,311,465,000 last year. These sales cover "wholesalers proper" and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

In April, thirteen of the seventeen specified trade groups covered in this report registered increased sales while the other four along with the "all other trades" group experienced decreased sales. The main increases were reported in groceries and food specialties (19.2 per cent), footwear (12.2 per cent) and clothing and furnishings (11.6 per cent) while reduced sales were evident mostly in farm machinery (13.3 per cent) and in the "all other trades" group (12.7 per cent).
