Sales of Canadian wholesalers in October were estimated at \$710,605,000, an increase of 8.2 per cent from the 1957 total of \$656,837,000. The combined sales for the first ten months of the year amounted to \$6,551,452,000, increasing slightly from the 1957 total of \$6,525,488,000 by 0.4 per cent. These sales cover "wholesalers proper" and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations, or number of business days in the respective months.

WHOLESALE TRADE

October sales rose sharply in all of the main trade groups covered by this report except one, as well as in the "all other trades" category. The greatest increase was registered in the sales of farm machinery (40.6 per cent), followed by smaller but substantial increases in clothing and furnishings (16.1 per cent), groceries and food specialties (13.5 per cent); the "all other trades" group rose by 15.5 per cent. The sales of all other groups increased by more than 2 per cent, except industrial and transportation equipment and supplies, and household electrical appliances which recorded smaller increases of 1.0 per cent and 1.1 per cent respectively. The only group showing a fall in sales was "coal and coke", decreasing by 13.1 per cent to \$17,902,000 from last year's total of \$20,600,000.
