Sales of Canadian wholesalers in September were estimated at $\$ 679,321,000$, an increase of 7.2 per cent from the 1957 September total of $\$ 633,891,000$. The comfined sales for the first nine months of this year amounted to $\$ 5,840,847,000$, falling short of the 1957 total of $\$ 5,868,651,000$ by 0.5 per cent. These sales cover "wholesalers proper" and do not include the business transactions of manfacturers" sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

Sales in September were larger than a year ago in 13 of the 17 specified trade groups covered in this report, as well as in the "all other" trades group. The increases were under 13 per cent in all cases except meat and dairy products where a 28.0 per cent increase was registered. Sales decreased 5.2 per cent in commercial, institutional and service equipment and supplies, 3.7 per cent in coal and coke, 3.1 per cent in industrial and transportation equipment and supplies and nominally in clothing and furnishings.
