## WHOLESALE TRADE

November, 1959

Sales of Canadian wholesalers, valued at \$643,147,000 for the month of November, were 1.9% higher than sales of \$630,967,000 estimated for the same month in 1958, placing the January - November total 8.8% above the corresponding period in 1958 at \$7,561,569,000 versus \$6,951,600,000. These sales cover "wholesalers proper" and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, for seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

November sales were larger for 14 of the specified trade groups, with increases ranging from 14.5% for farm machinery to Q9% for meat and dairy products. Other gains were: commercial, institutional and service equipment and supplies (14.0%), newsprint, paper and paper products (11.8%), fresh fruits and vegetables (11.6%), tobacco, confectionery and soft drinks (10.8%), automotive parts and accessories (8.7%), groceries and food specialties (7.6%), footwear (6.7%), household electrical appliances (5.8%), other textile and clothing accessories (3.6%), hardware (2.7%). Decreases were recorded for coal and coke (3.8%), construction materials and supplies, including lumber (1.3%), industrial and transportation equipment and supplies (0.6%). The "all other trades" group also showed a decrease of 7.9%.

Jamuary - November sales were higher for all trades except coal and coke and meat and dairy products which registered declines of 5.8% and 3.0% respectively. Increases in the period were between 24.8% for farm machinery and 1.9% for other textile and clothing accessories.
