# WHOLESALE TRADE <br> Augrast, $19: 19$ 

Sales of Canadian wholesalers for the month of August were estimatan at $\$ 624,265,000$, up $7.6 \%$ from sales of $\$ 580,29 \%, 000$ reported for the same month in 1958. Total sales for the first eight months of the year increased by 10 to $\$ 5,494,838,000$ from sales of $\$ 4,995,062,000$ for the corresponding period in 1958 . These sales cover wholesalers proper" and do rot include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of trusiness days in the respective months.

All but three of the 18 trade grcups comprising this report recorded increases for the month of August ranging from 39.5\% for farm machinery to $0.7 \%$ for fresh fruits and vegetables. Other trades reporting substantini increases were: comercial, institutional and service equipment and supplies (18.5\%), the "all other trades" group ( $I_{4}$ I\%), newsprint, paper and paper products ( $12.4 \%$ ), drugs and drug sundries (12.18), automotive parts and accessories (11.6\%), groceries and food specialties ( $9.2 \%$ ). Decreases were registered for coal and coke ( $22.5 \%$ ), meat and dairy products ( $11.2 \%$ ), clothing and furnishings (1.7\%).
