

Files of Canadian wholesalers, valued at $\$ 619,041,000$ for the month of Jamary, were $3.9 \%$ higher than sales of $\$ 595,956,000$ estimated for the samemonth in 1059 . These sales cover "wholesalers proper" and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers? sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjustof for price charges, seasonal variäions or mumber of business days in the respective months.

Jamary sales were larger than a yoar earlier for 9 of the 1.1 spo cified trade groups covered in this report. Increases ranged from $16.5 \%$ for commercial, institutional and service equiment and supplies to $1.3 \%$ for farm machinery. The "all other trades" group showed an increase of $8.4 \%$. Decreases ranged from $8.3 \%$ for coal and coke to $1.6 \%$ in the case of drugs and drug sundries
