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## WHOLESALE IRADE <br> October, 1960

Sales of Canadian Wholesalers for the month of October were estimated at $\$ 689,751,000$ as compared with $\$ 721,015,000$ for the same month of 1959, a decrease of 403 p.c. Cumulative sales for the first 10 months, 1960 , at $\$ 7,010,957,000$ were but. 1.1 pec. over the first 10 months of the previous year. These sales cover wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches, or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or member of business days in the respective months.

October sales were lower in eleven of the seventeen specified trade groups covered in this report as compared with sales th the same month of 1959, the most significant decreases being those of the following trades: Coal and Coke: 12.1 p.c.; Hardware: 10.1 p.c.; Construction Materials and Supplies: 9.9 p.c., and Household Electrical Appliances: 7.7 pec. Among the groups which showed increases, Commercial, Institutional and Service Equipment and applies registered the largest with sales 5.7 pec. over October, 1959, while Industrial and Transportation Equip= mont and Supplies ranked second with 2.6 pec.
