

WHOLESALE TRADE

October, 1960

Sales of Canadian Wholesalers for the month of October were estimated at \$689,751,000 as compared with \$721,015,000 for the same month of 1959, a decrease of 4.3 p.c. Cumulative sales for the first 10 months, 1960, at \$7,010,957,000 were but 1.1 p.c. over the first 10 months of the previous year. These sales cover wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers sales branches, or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

October sales were lower in eleven of the seventeen specified trade groups covered in this report as compared with sales in the same month of 1959, the most significant decreases being those of the following trades: Goal and Coke: 12.1 p.c.; Hardware: 10.1 p.c.; Construction Materials and Supplies: 9.9 p.c.; and Household Electrical Appliances: 7.7 p.c. Among the groups which showed increases, Commercial, Institutional and Service Equipment and Supplies registered the largest with sales 5.7 p.c. over October, 1959, while Industrial and Transportation Equipment and Supplies ranked second with 2.6 p.c.
