## WHOLESALE TRADE

May, 1960
Sales of Canadian wholesalers for the month of May were estimated at $\$ 783,935,000$, up $4.0 \%$ from sales of $\$ 753,685,000$ reported for the same month in 1959. These sales cover "wholesalers proper" and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

Eleven of the 17 specified trade groups recorded increases ranging from $11.4 \%$ for automotive parts and accessories to $0.3 \%$ for newsprint, paper and paper products. The "all other trades" group had an increase of $8.0 \%$. Lower sales were registered in 6 of the specified groups ranging from $14.5 \%$ for household electrical appliances to $0.7 \%$ for industrial and transportation equipment and supplies. Sales for the first 5 months of the year increased by $4.6 \%$ to $\$ 3,542,179,000$ with 4 of the specified trades showing decreases ranging from $6.9 \%$ for construction materials and supplies to $1.1 \%$ for other textiles and clothing accessories. Two of the trades - clothing and furnishing and coal and coke - recorded no change in sales.
