

## WHOLESALE TRADE

August, 1960

Sales of Canadian wholesalers for the month of August were estimated at $\$ 657,811,000$, up $5.0 \%$ from sales of $\$ 626,683,000$ reported for the same month in 1959 These sales cover wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

Fourteen of the 17 specified trade groups recorded increased sales ranging from 0.5\% for tobacco, confectionery and soft drinks to $17.8 \%$ for meat and dairy products. Decreases ranged from $23.5 \%$ for farm machinery to $3.0 \%$ for construction materials and supplies including lumber. January-August sales at $\$ 5,635,484,000$ were $2.4 \%$ higher than sales for the corresponding period in 1959, with increases registered for 11 of the specified trade groups.
