WHOLESALE TRADE

September, 1960

Sales of Canadian wholesalers for the month of September at $\$ 685,722,000$ were $2.8 \%$ below sales of $\$ 705,539,000$ reported for the same month in 1959. These sales cover wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

All but 6 of the 17 specified trade groups reported reduced sales ranging from $29.3 \%$ for farm machinery to $0.2 \%$ for automotive parts and accessories. Increases were recorded for newsprint, paper and paper products (9.1\%), groceries and food specialties ( $8.1 \%$ ), commercial, institutional and service equipment and supplies ( $7.5 \%$ ), footwear ( $7.0 \%$ ), tobacco, confectionery and soft drinks (2. \%\%), drugs and sundries (1.0\%). January - September sales increased by 1.8\% to $\$ 6,321,206,000$, with 7 of the specified trades showing appreciable decline in sales.
