#### WHOLESALE TRADE

#### January, 1961

Sales of Canadian wholesalers, valued at \$570,173,000 for the month of January were 7.1% lower than the sales of \$613,939,000 estimated for the same month in 1960. These sales cover "wholesalers proper" and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

January sales were larger than a year earlier for 11 of the 17 specified trade groups covered in this report. Increases ranged from 3%.3% for household electrical appliances to 1.9% for groceries and food products. Decreases ranged from 16.2% for coal and coke to 1.3% for automotive parts and accessories. The "all other trades" group showed a decrease of 24.5%.


