## WHOLESALE TRADE



February, 1961

Sales of Canadian Wholesalers for the month of February are estimated at $\$ 610,091,000$, down $9 \%$ from sales of $\$ 670,337,000$ estimated for the same month of 1960. Sales for the first two months of the year, at $\$ 1,180,264,000$, were $8.1 \%$ lower than the sales of $\$ 1,284,326,000$ for the corresponding period of 1960. These sales cover wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches, or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

February sales were larger in eight of the seventeen specified trade groups, the most important increases being in the following trades: Farm Machinery, 23\%; Household Electrical Appliances, 22.5\%; Footwear, 11. $8 \%$; Meat and Dairy Products, 8.2\%. Decreases occurred in nine trades and ranged from 14.3\% for Coal and Coke to $0.2 \%$ for Fresh Fruits and Vegetables. The MAll Other Trades" group showed a decrease of $24.9 \%$.
