## WHOLESALE TRADE

April sales of Canadian wholesalers are estimated at $\$ 672,197,000$, down 3\% from sales of $\$ 692,840,000$ in April, 1960. These sales cover "wholesalers proper" and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

Eight of the 17 specified trade groups recorded increases ranging from 15.7\% for Household Electrical Appliances to 0.3\% for Automotive Parts and Accessories. Other trades showing increases were: Newsprint, Paper and Paper Products, 11.2\%; Commercial, Institutional and Service Equipment and Supplies, 7.4\%; Grocertes and Food Specialties, $6.0 \%$; Footwear, 3.6\%; Drugs and Drug Sundries, 3.6\% and Hardware 2. $8 \%$. Decreases were largest for Clothing and Furnishings, 20.0\%; and smallest for Tobacco, Confectionery and Soft Drinks, 0.6\%. The "All Other Trades" group shows a decrease of $10.0 \%$.

For the first four months of the year, sales are estimated at $\$ 2,574_{5}$ 353,000 as compared with $\$ 2,742,470,000$ for the same period of 1960, a decrease of $6.9 \%$.
