## HOLESALTMRADE <br> January, 1962

Balas of Canadian wholesalers for January are estimated at $3696,703,000$, as Inciesse of 16.5 per cent compared with the same month of 1961 . Sales are those of "Wholesalers proper" and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers? sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

Starting this year, the trade "electrical Wiring Supplies, Construction Materials, apparatus and Equipment" has been added to our list of specified trade groups covered in this report and the trade "Construction Materials and Supplies, including Lumber", which formerly include od wholesale establishments primarily engaged in handing electrical equipment and supplies used in the Construction industry, now has the heading "Other Construction Materials and Supplies, including Turban".

Sixteen of the 18 specified trade groups show increases ranging from 17.7 per cont Pc Other Construction Materials and Supplies, including Lumber to 0.2 per cont for Other Textile and Clothing Accessories. Decreases were 22.7 per cent for Barm Machinery and 2.6 per cont for Coal and Coke. The "All Other Trades" group shoved as increase of 30.7 per cent.
