Sales are those of "Wholesalers Proper" and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, soasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

Sixteen trades inaicatcâ an incroased volume op business. Increases ranged from 28.3 por cent in the case of Clothinis and Furnishings to 5.0 per cent for lieat and Dairy Products and Hardware. The residual group of trades showed an increase of 20.3 per cent. The remaining two trades indicated decreases of 7.7 per cont and 1.0 per cont.

For the four months ending April, sales are estimated at $\$ 3,043,434,000$, an increase of 12.6 per cent when compared with the same period of 1961. All trades except two indicated increases ranging from 26.6 per cont in the case of Cther Construction Naterials and Supplies includinf Lumber to 2.1 per cent for Heat and Dairy Products. Coal and Coke and Farm: Machinery indicated decreases of 5.5 per cent and 4.9 per cent respectively. The residual group of trades showed an increase of 2 .. 3 per cont for the four month period.
