Sales of Canadian wholesalers for June are estimated at $\$ 879,941,000$, an therease of 6.6 per cent compared with the same period for 1961. Sales are those of "Wholesalers Proper" and do not include the business transactions of manutacturers' sales branches or agents and brckers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of tusiness days in the respective months.

All except six trades indicated an ircreased volume of business. Increases ranged from 20,7 per cent in the case of Commercial, Institutional and Service Equipment and Supplies to 2.1 per cent for Other Construction Materials and Supplies, including Lumber. Decreases in the six trades ranged from 17.8 per Gent for Coal and Coke to 0.7 per cent in the case of Clothing and Furnishings. The residual group of trades showed an increase of 16.7 per cent.

For the six months ending June 1962 , sales are estimated at $\$ 4,869,598,000$, an warease of 11.5 per cent when compared with the same period of 1961. All trades except Coal and coke (decrease of 7.5 per cent) showed an increase in business for the period. Increases ranged from 13.4 per cent in the case of 0 her Construction Materials and Supplies, including Lumber to 0.4 per cent for Meat and Dairy Products. The residual group of trades showed an increase of 22.0 per cent for the period.
