MHOLESALE TRADE<br>January, 1963


 contains final revised estinates of wholesale sales for the years 1960 ana igh, also preliminary estimates for the year 1962. On pages 4 and 5 there are revised monthly estimates for the year 1962. Finally on page 6 final estimates of yearend wholesale inventories for selected trades are shown for the years 1960 and 1961; rreliminary estimates are shown for the year 1962.

January 1963 sales of Canadian wholesalers were etimated at $3756,296,000$, an increase of $5.5 \%$ over January 1962 sales of $\$ 713,273,000$. All trades except three indicated an increase, increases raneing from $27.6 \%$ in the case of Farm Niachinery to $0.2 \%$ for Other Construction Materials and Supplies, including Lumber. Three trades indicated a decrease; Clothing and Furnishings 16.7\%, Tobacco, Confectionary and Soft Drinks $4.7 \%$ and Croceries and Food Specialties $0.2 \%$. The All Other Trades group showed an increase of $12.9 \%$.

Por the year 1962 sales of Canadian wholesalers were estimated at $\$ 9,800,200,000$, an increase of $10.9 \%$ over sales of $\$ 8,836,600,000$ for the year 1.961. All trades except one indicated an increased volume of business, increases ranging from 9.3\% in the case of Groceries and Food Specialties to $0.7 \%$ in the case of Meat and Dairy Products. The Coal and Coke trade indicated a decrease in sales of 0.9\%. The All Other Trades group indicated an increase of $15.4 \%$.

These sales estinates cover the transactions of "Wholesalers proper" and do not include those of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.
hil trades for which it is possible to show year-end inventory data for the years 1961 and 1962 indicated increases in inventory holdings, increases ranging frora $22.7 \%$ in the case of Newsprint, Paper and Paper Products to $0.5 \%$ in the case of Groceries ana rood Specielties.
