WHOLESALE TRADE January, 1963

Estimates of wholesale sales for the month of January 1958 ARY comparable figures for 1962 will be found on page 2 of this Territor Trage 3 contains final revised estimates of wholesale sales for the years 1960 and 1961, also preliminary estimates for the year 1962. On pages 4 and 5 there are revised monthly estimates for the year 1962. Finally on page 6 final estimates of yearend wholesale inventories for selected trades are shown for the years 1960 and 1961; preliminary estimates are shown for the year 1962.

January 1963 sales of Canadian wholesalers were estimated at 752,292,000, an increase of 5.5% over January 1962 sales of \$713,273,000. All trades except three indicated an increase, increases ranging from 27.6% in the case of Farm Machinery to 0.2% for Other Construction Materials and Supplies, including Lumber. Three trades indicated a decrease; Clothing and Furnishings 16.7%, Tobacco, Confectionery and Soft Drinks 4.7% and Groceries and Food Specialties 0.2%. The All Other Trades group showed an increase of 12.9%.

For the year 1962 sales of Canadian wholesalers were estimated at 99,800,200,000, an increase of 10.9% over sales of \$8,836,600,000 for the year 1961. All trades except one indicated an increased volume of business, increases ranging from 9.3% in the case of Groceries and Food Specialties to 0.7% in the case of Meat and Dairy Products. The Coal and Coke trade indicated a decrease in sales of 0.9%. The All Other Trades group indicated an increase of 15.4%.

These sales estimates cover the transactions of "Wholesalers proper" and do not include those of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

All trades for which it is possible to show year-end inventory data for the years 1961 and 1962 indicated increases in inventory holdings, increases ranging from 22.7% in the case of Newsprint, Paper and Paper Products to 0.5% in the case of Groceries and Food Specialties.

Further detail on the sales and inventories of the various trade groups will be found on the following pages.
