## THOLESALE TRADE

October, 1963


Sales of Canadian wholesalers for the month of October are estimated at $\$ 922,354,000$, an increase of $8.7 \%$ over the same month of 1962. These sales are those of wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers? sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

October sales were larger in fifteen of the eighteen specified trade groups. Increases ranged from 35.2 for farm machinery to $0.5 \%$ for hardware. Decreases in the three remaining trade groups were $5.7 \%$ for Footwear, $4.5 \%$ for Other Textile and Clothing Accessories and $2.7 \%$ for Commercial, Institutional and Service Equipment and Supplies. The "All Other Trades" group showed an increase of 6.6 䭅。

For the first ten months of the year, sales are estimated at $\$ 8,599,859,000$, an increase of $5.1 \%$ over the same period of 1962. With the exception of minor decreases in the sales of Meat and Dairy Products, Clothing and Furnishings and Hardware, all of the specified trade groups showed increases ranging from $17.8 \%$ for Farm Machinery to 0.2 for Tobacco, Confectionery and Soft Drinks. The residual group of trades showed an increase of $7.3 \%$.
