

WHOLESALE TRADE

March, 1963



Sales of Canadian wholesalers for March are estimated at \$51,151,000, an increase of 0.4% as compared with the same month in 1962. Sales are those of "Wholesalers proper" and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

March 1963 sales were larger in seven of the eighteen specified trade groups, with increases ranging from 10.8% for Industrial and Transportation equipment and Supplies to 0.2% in the case of Automotive Parts and Accessories. All other trade groups indicated decreases ranging from 9.6% in the case of Clothing and Furnishings to 1.0% for Coal and Coke. The residual "All Other Trades" showed an increase of 3.1%.

For the three months ending March, sales are estimated at \$2,381,236,000, an increase of 3.9% when compared with the same period of 1962. Thirteen trades indicated increases while the remaining five showed decreases. The All Other Trades group showed an increase of 8.1% for the period.
