

Sales of Canadian wholesalers for the month of February are estimated at $\$ 872,961,000$, an increase of $15.7 \%$ over the same month of 1963. These sales are those of wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

Febmary sales were larger in fifteen of the eighteen specified trade groups. Increases ranged from 71.1\% for Farm Machinery to 1.4\% for Automotive Parts and Accessories. Decreases in the three remaining trades were $11.9 \%$ for Coal and Coke, 1.28 for Tobacco, Confectionery and Soft Drinks and $0.7 \%$ for Fresh Fruits and Vegetables. The "All Other Trades" group showed an increase of $26.5 \%$.

For the first two months of the year, sales are estimated at $\$ 1,722,698,000$, an increase of $14.3 \%$ over the same period of 1963 . With the exception of an $11.3 \%$ decrease for Coal and Coke, all trade groups showed increases ranging from $43.6 \%$ for Farm Machinery to $1.3 \%$ for Tobacco, Confectionery and Soft Drinks.
