## WHOLESALE TRADE

March. 1964

Sales of Canadian wholesalers for the month of March, at \$1,022,636,000, were 20.8% greater than the \$846,821,000 reported for the same month of 1964. These sales cover wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

All but one of the eighteen specified trade groups reported increased sales. Increases ranged from 61.2% for Farm Machinery to 0.8% for Tobacco, Confectionery and Soft Drinks. The Coal and Coke group showed a decrease of 8.1%. The "All Other Trades" group showed an increase of 25.2%.

For the first three months of the year, sales are estimated at \$2,745,334,000, an increase of 16.6% over the same period of 1963. With the exception of a 10.4% decrease in Coal and Coke, all trade groups showed increases ranging from 52.1% for Farm Machinery to 3.0% for Automotive Parts and Accessories.
