

Sales of Cancdian wholesalers for the month of April are estimated at $\$ 1,041,236,000$, an increase of $8.6 \%$ over the same month of 1964 . These sales are those of wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.
npril sales were larger in fifteen of the eighteen specified trade group. Increases ranged from 18.9; in Industrial and Transportation Equipment and Supplies to l.5\% in Footwear. Decreases in the three remaining trades ranged from 2.7\% in Newsprint, Paper and Paper Products to 0.6\% in Hardware. The "All Other Trades" group showed an increase of 11.6 .

For the first four months of the year, sales are estimated at $\$ 3,937,232,000$, an increase of $6.1 \%$ over the sane period in 1964. Fourteen of the specified trades reported increases ranging from 12. $1, \%$ for Comnercial, Institutional and Service Equipment and Supplies to 0.2: for Industrial and Transportation Equipnent and Supplies, while the other four showed decreases rangint from $4 . \mathrm{E}_{6}$ for Hardware to 0.8 for Other Textile and Clothing Accessorios. The "hll Other Trades" group shoved an increase of 9.8 .
