Sales of Canadian wholesalers for the month of July are estimated at $\$ 1,011,228,000$, an increase of $14.5 \%$ over the same month in 1964 . These sales are those of wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations, or number of business days in the respective months.

July 1965 sales were larger in fourteen of the eighteen specifled trade groups. Increases ranged from $1.1 \%$ in Tobacco, Confectionery and Soft Drinks to $14.4 \%$ in Industrial and Transportation Equipment and Supplies. Decreases in the four remaining trades ranged from $1.2 \%$ in Clothing and Furnishings to $5.0 \%$ in Other Textile and Clothing Accessories. The "All Other Trades" group showed an increase of $46.4 \%$.

For the first seven months of the year, sales are estimated at $\$ 7,230,020,000$, an increase of $9.5 \%$ over the same period in 1964. Sixteen of the specified trades showed increases ranging from $0.7 \%$ in Hardware to $15.7 \%$ in Fresh Frults and Vegetables. Decreases in the two remaining trades, namely Footwear and Other Textile and Clothing Accessories amounted to $0.8 \%$ and $0.9 \%$, respectively. The "All Other Trades" group showed an increase of $15.7 \%$.
