WHOLESALE TRADE
January 1966


Estimates of wholesale sales for the month of January 1966 end comparable figures for the same month in 1965 will be found on page 2 of this report. Page contains the final revised estimates of wholesale sales for the years 1963 and 1964: also revised estimates for the year 1965. On pages 4 and 5 there are revised monthly estimates for the year 1965. Finally, on page 6 final estimates for yearend wholesale inventories for selected trades are shown for the years 1963 and 1964; revised estimates for the year 1965.

January 1966 sales of Canadian wholesalers were estimated at $\$ 933,358,000$, or 9.2 over the January 1965 sales of $\$ 851,453,000$. These sales cover wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the various months.

A comparison of sales figures for January 1966 with those for the same month in 1965 shows that of the eighteen specified trade groups, seventeen recorded increases ranging from $70.3 \%$ in Fam Machinery to 1.5 \% in Household Electrical Appliances; the decrease, in Coal and Coke, was 26.18 . The "All Other Trades" group reported an increase of $5.7 \%$.

Sales of Canadian wholvialer3 for the year 1965 are estimated at $\$ 12,170,100,000$ after revision, an increase of $10.4 \%$ over the In al estimate of 1964. Revised figures showed increases in all specified trades, ranging from $16.6 \%$ in Meat and 'fairy Products to $0.6 \%$ in Hardware. The "All Other Trades" group recorded an increase of $18.2 \%$.

Estimated year-ond inventories for the period 1963 to 1963 ais published on page 6 for six selected trades for which estimates are available. Inadequate response to the sample survey prevents the publication of inventory data for the remainiry trades and the "A": ? incr Trades" group.
