

Sales of Canadian wholesalers for the month of February 1966 are estimated at \$971,158,000, an increase of 7.0% over the same month in 1965. These sales are those of wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

February sales were greater in sixteen of the eighteen specified trades. Increases ranged from 5.6% in Fresh Fruits and Vegetables to 34.3% in Farm Machinery. The decreases in the other two trades were 8.0% in Footwear and 9.2% in Coal and Coke. Sales in the "All Other Trades" group decreased by 2.3%.

For the first two months of the year, sales are estimated at \$1,904,516,000, an increase of 8.1% over the same period in 1965. Sixteen of the specified trades showed increases, ranging from 3.7% in Fresh Fruits and Vegetables to 43.9% in Farm Machinery. Decreases in the two remaining trades were 4.3% in Footwear and 18.0% in Coal and Coke. Sales of the "All Other Trades" group increased by 1.7%.
