Sales of Canadian wholesalers for the month of June 1967 are estimated at $\$ 1,237,100,000$, an increase of 6.50 over the same month in 1966 . These sales are those of wholesalers proper and do not include the business trarsactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

June sales were greater in sixtecn of the eighteen specified trades. lncreases ranced from $3.0 \%$ in Industrial and transportation equipment and supplies to 17.18 in Meat and dairy products. Decreases in the two other trades ranged from 0.1\% in Footwear to 21.2\% in Coal and coke. Sales in the "All other trades" group increased by $5.5 \%$.

For the first six months of 1967 , sales are estimated at $\$ 6,821,820,000$, an increase of $3.8 \%$ over the same period in 1966. Seventeer of the specified trades showed increases, ranging from $1.5 \%$ in Footwear to $14.2 \%$ in Commercial, institutional and service equipment and supplies. The one remaining trade, Coal and coke, recorded a slight decrease of $0.3 \%$. Sales of the "All other trades" group leclined by $2.5 \%$.
