

WHOLESALE TRADE

July 1967



Sales of Canadian wholesalers for the month of July 1967 are estimated at \$1,017,495,000, an increase of 3.7% over the same month in 1966. These sales are those of wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

July sales were greater in sixteen of the eighteen specified trades. Increases ranged from 0.4% in Newsprint, paper and paper products to 19.7% in Footwear. Decreases in the other two trades, Farm machinery and Meat and dairy products, were 1.6% and 5.1% respectively. Sales in the "All other trades" group declined by 8.0%.

For the first seven months of 1967, sales are estimated at \$7,839,315,000, an increase of 3.7% over the same period in 1966. All of the eighteen specified trades showed increases, ranging from 0.4% in Coal and coke to 14.0% in Commercial, institutional and service equipment and supplies. Sales of the "All other trades" group declined by 3.1%.
