WHOLESALE TRADE

August 1967

Sales of Canadian wholesalers for the month of August 1967 are estimated at \$1,083,872,000, an increase of 4.5% over the same month in 1966. These sales are those of wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

August sales were greater in thirteen of the eighteen specified trades. Increases ranged from 1.5% in Drugs and drug sundries to 21.4% in Commercial, institutional and service equipment and supplies. Decreases in the other five trades ranged from 2.2% in Meat and dairy products to 34.4% in Farm machinery. Sales in the "All other trades" group increased by 5.2%.

For the first eight months of 1967, sales are estimated at \$8,923,187,000, an increase of 3.8% over the same period in 1966. Seventeen of the eighteen specified trades showed increases which ranged from 2.6% in Industrial and transportation equipment and supplies to 14.9% in Commercial, institutional and service equipment and supplies. Sales of the remaining trade, Coal and coke, decreased by 1.0%. Sales of the "All other trades" group decreased by 2.3%.
